Conditions of entry:

Moorings are at the absolute discretion of the moorings officer and may be changed at any time. The moorings officer reserves the right to remove any boat from its moorings prior to and during the gathering should, in his/her opinion, the necessity arise. Anyone refusing directions of any mooring officer or his staff will be removed from site. Please be aware that the festival organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage to persons or property however caused and their ruling on all matters is final.

Moorings for disabled boaters will be allocated on a first come first served basis and may be limited in number. A copy of your disabled badge must be displayed on the boat and a copy must be sent with your mooring application, (these moorings may be anywhere on the towpath but will have good boat to bank access and will have good access to adjoining paths and highways).

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.

Third party insurance to the minimum of £ one million (£1,000,000) must be held.

A current licence covering the relevant waterway must be displayed.

Toilets must not be discharged into the waterway.

All boaters and their occupants must comply with the conditions in the mooring officer's instructions.

All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. You must clean up and safely dispose of dog dirt immediately. Adults are responsible for their children at all times. Information on this form may in whole or in part be recorded on a computer registered under data protection Act 1984. In accordance with that Act, data recorded under your name may be inspected on application to the moorings officer. Please supply a stamped addressed envelope if an acknowledgement of this entry is required. Most boats will be double or triple moored to enable more boats to be centrally located. If this is unacceptable please indicate on your booking form.

Block bookings will only be accepted if received in the same envelope. Late additions may not be added.

Bookings for moorings will be allocated on a best fit, participation etc. Once available moorings are full, boats will have to moor at the closest convenient location.

No trading from boats or distribution of promotional material will be permitted. Unless by prior arrangement. Promotional material must be distributed from a central location e.g. the event stand and not from the craft.
