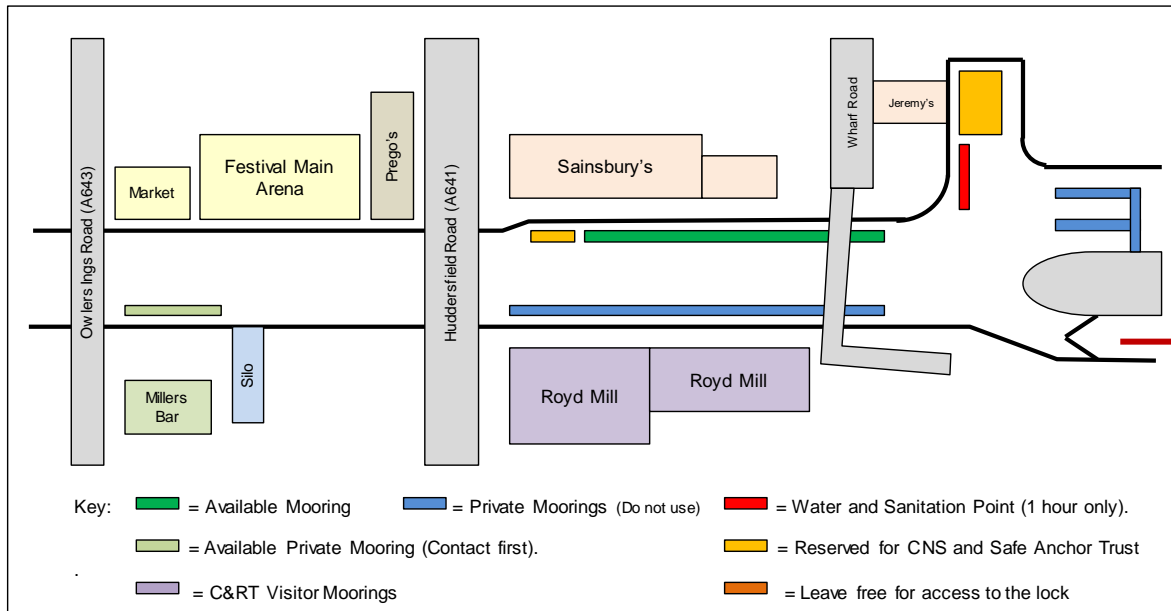


# Mooring at Brighouse Summer Festival 2017

Moorings within the Brighouse Basin and on the Calder and Hebble Canal are available on a 'first come' basis and cannot be reserved. Moorings in the marina and outside Royd Mill are private and must not be used. Moorings at the old swimming pool are no longer available as it is now a secure construction site. In the case of Miller's Bar, you must contact them first to obtain permission to moor.

Moorings are also available above Ganney Lock, the first lock immediately west of Brighouse on the way towards to Sowerby Bridge. There are no moorings on the River Calder downstream of Brighouse. Boats may be double moored but please be careful where you moor so as not to restrict the manoeuvring and movement of other boats, in particular the boat trips provided by the Calder Navigation Society and the Safe Anchor Trust that will be on the canal between Ganney Lock and the Brighouse Marina all day, one of which is a broad beam.
